The whole school gathered in the Chapel on Friday morning to mark the passing of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II. Reverend Vindra reflected on her long and inspirational life of selfless service, and the importance of her Christian faith. A-Level and GCSE Results

This is indeed a time for solemn reflection, but we would nonetheless like to honour the achievements of Queenswood pupils who sat public exams this summer. At **A-Level**, 70% of grades awarded were A*–B, enabling students to progress to a range of prestigious degree courses, including PPE at Oxford, Classics at St Andrews and Maths with Statistics at King's College London. At **GCSE**, 63% of grades awarded were 7 or above.
